- (c) To ensure involvement of governments and states in the affairs of citizens with disability.

- (e) To exchange technology and skills to enhance quality of products.

These competitions at international level, are held every four years. Japan, the initiator of Abilympics held- it for the first time in 1981. The Abilympics have helped to change the traditional view with regard to the skills, potential and abilities of persons with disabilities or challenge.
